Shared Use Cycling – Greenbank Road

I recently wrote to you to inform you of the proposal regarding the development on Greenbank Road. It has been brought to my attention that the drawing that was issued was not the most up to date version.

Please accept my apologies for any inconvenience this may have caused.

After discussions between the developer and Liverpool City Council it was decided that the section of footway adjacent to the new development would be shared use and not segregated. A shared use area enables cyclists and pedestrians to mix freely and share the full width of the route.

As part of the conditions of the planning approval it was a requirement of the developer to include provisions for cyclists adjacent to the development. As such the proposed cycle infrastructure does not form part of a wider cycling strategy and any considerations for further cycle development would be beyond the scope of this scheme.

Please find the attached drawing No.CO00205241-Cons-01 Rev A detailing all proposals.
